3-year-olds Objectives & Goals

PRESCHOOL OBJECTIVES

SPIRITUAL

- The students will demonstrate their knowledge of God by answering questions about Bible stories that have been taught to them. Students will recite age appropriate memory verses.
- The students will demonstrate their understanding of the concept of giving by participating in a community service project.
- The students will show God's love to other students by sharing and helping each other in group settings.

ACADEMIC

Math: Learning is reinforced through art work, literature, centers and games.

- Students will be able to name basic shapes: square, circle, triangle, rectangle.
- Students will be able to rote count to ten (10) or more.
- Students will be able to do simple patterns, i.e. red, green, red --- both orally and visually.
- Students will be able to compare and distinguish sizes of two objects, large/small.

Pre Reading

- Students will be able to answer questions from a story read by the teacher.
- Students will be able to read picture stories for meaning.
- Students will begin to recognize letters of the alphabet.
- Students will recognize own name.

Pledges

- Students will recite the Pledges (American flag, Christian flag, and the Bible) each day.

Science

- Through the use of centers, stories and hands-on activities, the students will realize that all creation comes from God.

SOCIAL

The students will demonstrate acceptable modes of behavior, i.e. listening, following directions, helping others, cooperating in group setting, putting away materials, obeying classroom rules, and using good manners at snack time, large group activities, and one-on-one with peers.

PHYSICAL

- Students will demonstrate the development of large muscles by running, hopping and marching.
- Students will demonstrate the development of small muscles by cutting, drawing, using crayons, paste, paint, working puzzles, stringing beads, printing name and alphabet letters.
- Students will demonstrate good health habits by washing hands after toileting and using a tissue when needed.
